- 1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to quash the order dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-3), whereby, the petitioner was declared as ‘Proclaimed Person” in case FIR No. 83 dated 07.10.2016 under Section 379-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Abohar, District Fazilka.
- 2. Vide order dated 09.08.2022, this Court had directed the petitioner to surrender before the Court within a period of 10 days and he was ordered to be admitted to interim bail.
- 3. During the course of the arguments, learned counsel for the parties submit that the petitioner has not surrendered before the Court in terms of the interim order dated 09.08.2022 passed by this Court, which disentitles the petitioner to any relief from this Court.
- 4. The petition is dismissed, accordingly.
