1. This application has been filed by the petitioner-applicant under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC read with High Court Rules and Orders for impleading 'Desh Bhagat University' as respondent No.5 in the writ petition.

2. In view of the averments made in the application, which is supported by an affidavit, same is allowed. Desh Bhagat University is impleaded as respondent No.5 in the writ petition subject to all just exceptions. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

CWP-14902 of 2023

1. Instant Writ Petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing 'seniority list' of Junior Engineer, Mechanical

(Annexure P-24), whereby educational qualification of the petitioner has not been entered and thereby petitioner’s name has not been included in the seniority list.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let this petition be disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 – Director, Department of Local Bodies, Punjab, to consider and decide the representation dated 10.01.2023 (Annexure P-19) submitted by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anju Sharma Kaushik, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr. J.S. Toor, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4.

5. Accordingly, and without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the same is disposed of only with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, that shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the same to the petitioner.

6. The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
