1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to take a final decision on letter dated 04.02.2016 (Annexure P-2), whereby recommendations of the Board of Directors dated 11.01.2016 have been sent to the Government for removing of anomalies with respect to grade pay particularly for the posts of Mandi Supervisor-cum-Fee Collector and Auction Recorder.

2. No one is present on behalf of the petitioners today. Even on the last two dates of hearing i.e. 17.01.2023 and 02.11.2023 also no one was present on behalf of the petitioners.
