AMARJOT BHATTI, J.

1. Petitioner-Amina has filed present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of (detenue) namely, Sania (daughter of the petitioner), aged about 15 years who was allegedly detained into custody by respondents No.5 to 9 and further for appointing Warrant Officer for the search of premises of private respondents.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that yesterday he has come to know that the minor girl has been taken to West Bengal. Therefore, he does not want to pursue the present petition and withdraws the same with liberty to file fresh one with correct particulars.
3. In view of this, the present writ petition stands dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforementioned.
