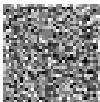

1. At the outset, learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 6, on instructions from Mr. Vikas, Lineman, O/o XEN (OP), Division DHBVN, Jind, submitted that now the compassionate financial assistance of Rs.2,50,000/- has been paid to the petitioner and so far as the interest component is concerned, since the Executive Engineer did not have power to sanction the interest component, he has already recommended to the Superintending Engineer for payment of interest @ 6% per annum (simple) and needful will be done within a period of three months from today.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner has already received the aforesaid amount of Rs.2,50,000/- and so far as the interest

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component is concerned, in view of the statement made by the learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 6, on instructions from the aforesaid official of the respondent-Nigam, the present writ petition may be disposed of as having become infructuous.
