RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the undertaking dated 22.11.2022 given by her in the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurugam and for disobeying the order dated 22.11.2022 passed by the above-said Court.
2. Reply by way of affidavit of the respondent filed in the Registry, is take on record.
3. A perusal of the case file shows that the order qua which the contempt is alleged by the petitioner has been passed by the Court of Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Gurugam. The said Court is having sufficient power and competence to get its own order(s) complied with. Therefore, this Court does not find it appropriate to continue with the present petition any more.
4. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to raise her grievance before the Court below, but in accordance with law.
