HARSH BUNGER J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner (Rajiv Sharma) has filed the instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside impugned order dated 06.05.2024 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Financial Commissioner, Punjab, Chandigarh, whereby orders dated 17.10.2023 and 19.12.2023 passed by the A.C. 1st Grade, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (respondent No.2) have been set aside and the case has been remanded back to respondent No.2 to decide afresh.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition, however, it is prayed that an appropriate direction may be issued to the A.C. 1st Grade, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur to decide the matter in a

time bound manner.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn. The A.C. 1st Grade, Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur (respondent No.2) is directed to make earnest endeavour to decide the matter expeditiously, preferably within a period of one year.
