The petitioners seek the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.246 dated 20.06.2023 under Sections 408, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sector 40, Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submit that pursuant to the interim order dated 04.12.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

The reply dated 25.01.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 04.12.2023 and are not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 04.12.2023 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
