AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. The prayer in the present Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for setting aside order dated 02.03.2016 passed by the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Punjab and directing the respondents to grant the petitioner seniority along with all consequential benefits and arrears from the date when the person next in order of merit was given appointment instead of 14.07.2014.
2. Learned State counsel makes reference to para No. 3 of the preliminary submissions as also to order dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure R-2) which was passed during the pendency of the writ petition wherein it has been mentioned that the prayer of the petitioner has been accepted and he has been appointed on notional basis w.e.f 28.10.2013 from the date when other meritorious candidates were issued offered appointment letter.
3. This satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the afore-said, the present petition stands disposed of.
