1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation dated 26.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner, for providing family pension to the petitioner w.e.f. 26.03.2015 along with arrears and interest.

2. Notice of motion in the present case was issued on 17.07.2023. On the said date learned counsel for the respondents accepted notice and sought time to get instructions with regard to the representation dated 26.03.2015 (Annexure P-2) made by the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions, submits that the brother of the petitioner namely Sh.Satpal S/o Jeet Ram has been addressed letter dated 08.05.2024 for completion of necessary formalities for processing the case of the petitioner for family pension,



however, he has not approached the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the brother of the petitioner shall visit the office of respondent No.4 on 20.05.2024 and shall complete the necessary documentation within a period of one week.

5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that on completion of necessary documentation by the petitioner, the case of the petitioner for grant of family pension shall be considered and finalized within a period of 02 months, thereafter.

6. Disposed of in view above terms and necessary benefits shall be released to the petitioner, accordingly.
