ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the original petitioner (Mohan Lal Saitia) had since passed away and his LR's have already been brought on record.

Learned Senior counsel for respondents No.2 to 4, at the outset, submits, for the petitioner was successful in the draw of lots, his entitlement for allotment of 200 S.Y. plot is not in dispute. However, he submits that an oustee certificate as also the necessary affidavit, to facilitate the process of formal allotment, are required to be submitted by the petitioner(s).

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that petitioner(s) shall comply with the necessary formalities as indicated by learned Senior counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 within a week from today.

Therefore, nothing substantive survives in the petition and the same be disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned Senior counsel for



respondents No.2 to 4.

In response, learned Senior counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 submits that in the event all the formalities are complied with, the regular letter of allotment will be issued without any further loss of time.

Further, as regards the issue concerning rates/price at which the allotment is to be made, learned counsel for the parties submit that the said question be kept open to be examined in an appropriate proceedings, if so advised.

The petition is, accordingly, disposed of in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties.
