AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

In the backdrop of settlement between the parties, the Insurance Company has not opposed the condonation of delay of 83 days in filing the present appeal at any juncture and as such, in view of the settlement that has been arrived between the parties, the delay in filing the appeal is condoned.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.90,000/- (Rupees Ninety Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid to the appellant-Harpal Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.90,000/- (Rupees Ninety Thousand Only) favouring appellant-Harpal Singh s/o Dharam Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.05.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount
