The instant petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.617 dated 27.12.2022 registered under Sections 15(b) and 27A of the NDPS Act, at Police Station City Tohana, District Fatehabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 14.07.2023 passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation but she opposed the petition on the ground that there are several other cases against the present petitioner.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the interim order dated 14.07.2023 is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C. subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) The petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, so as to dissuade him to disclose such facts to the Court or to any other authority.*
- (ii) The petitioner shall surrender his passports, if any, (if already not surrendered), and in case he is not holder of the same, he shall swear an affidavit to that effect.*
- (v) The petitioner shall also file his affidavit before the concerned I.O./Arresting Officer, mentioning his ordinary place of residence and number of mobile phone, which shall be used by him during the pendency of the case. In case of change of place of residence/mobile number, he shall share the details with the concerned Investigating Officer.*
- (vi) In case, the petitioner involves in any other criminal activity, during the pendency of the case, it shall be viewed seriously and the prosecution shall be at liberty to move a petition for cancellation of bail granted to him.*
