AMARJOT BHATTI, J (Oral):

1. Status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.
2. As per status report, statements of petitioners have been recorded confirming that at present they do not apprehend any threat to their family members nor they need any security. Statement of Jai Parkash respondent No.4 is also recorded who for himself as well as for his son confirmed that petitioner No.1 has performed marriage as per her sweet will and now she has no connection with their family and they will not interfere in their married life.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners stated that in view of the status report, present petition be disposed of.
4. Considering the aforesaid status report, as far now petitioners do not apprehend any threat to their life and liberty. Therefore, no further direction are required. Present petition stands disposed of having rendered infructuous.
