1. The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 0018, dated, 18.03.2024, registered at Police Station Women, Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 376 (2) (n), 323 and 506 of the IPC read with Section 120-B thereof.
2. The petitioner was directed to join the investigation, as per the order 12.07.2024.
3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from SI Baljeet Kaur, has confirmed that the petitioner has joined investigation in compliance of the order order 12.07.2024. The investigation of the case is complete and even challan/final report under

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Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been presented before the trial Court and further custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

4. In view of the reasons recorded in the order dated 12.07.2024 and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has joined investigation, his further custodial interrogation is not required by the Investigating Agency, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.07.2024 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, it is made clear that nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of opinion on merits of the case.
