1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 20.12.2016 (Annexure P-12) whereby respondent has rejected his claim for release of arrears of 90% provisional pension w.e.f. 30.03.2013 to 19.12.2016.

2. Mr. Sehajbir Singh Aulakh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab submits that case of the petitioner falls within the clutches of Rule 2.2(b) of PCS Rules, thus, respondent has right to withhold pension. The respondent has not withheld future pension, however, decided to withhold arrears till the adjudication of criminal appeal which is pending before this Court.
