Challenge in the present writ petition is to the interim stay order passed by the State Registrar of Firms and Societies, Haryana, Chandigarh dated 24.06.2024 whereby, he is directed to stay the election process which is associated to the Residents Welfare Association i.e. New Town Heights, Sector-86, Condominium Association.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Parul Saini, Advocate, Mobile No. 9650810380, who is present in the Court, is appointed as a Legal Aid Counsel to assist this Court on behalf of the petitioner.



The Legal Aid Counsel for the petitioner has been confronted with the fact that the orders passed by the State Registrar of Societies are amenable to challenge by way of a revision petition before the Registrar General of Societies under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012.

Counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the said aspect and submits on instructions from the the petitioner who is present in person that she may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition at this stage with liberty to approach the Registrar General of Societies and that an indulgence may be granted that in the event of the petitioner preferring a petition before the Registrar General, a decision on the interim prayer may be taken expeditiously.

Learned State Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents has no objection to the same. The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of as withdrawn at this stage with the consent of the parties and without commenting on the merits with liberty to the petitioner to prefer a revision petition before the Registrar General of the Societies, Haryana under the Haryana Registration and Regulation of Societies Act, 2012.

Needless to mention that in the event of the petitioner preferring any such revision petition before the Registrar General, an expeditious decision shall be taken thereupon and especially on an application for seeking an interim relief, in due process of law and after affording opportunity of hearing to the respective parties.
