Appellant Bimla Devi as well as his son appellant Vikas are present in person. They have produced their copies of aadhaar cards in order to establish their identities.

Mr. Sandeep Suri, Advocate, appearing for the respondent-National Insurance Company Limited has submitted that the matter has been amicably settled for an amount of Rs.4,00,000/- (Four Lakhs) over and above the amount granted by the Tribunal.

As agreed above, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent– National Insurance Company Limited(separately recorded), a sum of Rs.4,00,000/- (Four Lakhs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant-Bimla Devi as well as his son appellant Vikas.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.4,00,000/- (Four Lakhs Only) in the name of appellant Bimla Devi as well as his son appellant Vikas with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before six weeks in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this

order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–National Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

The amount as agreed be released to the appellants as per award in their individual name, however, with the condition that the other claimants will be entitled to claim their share of compensation, if they so desire, in accordance with law.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
