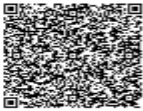

KIRTI SINGH, J.(Oral)

This petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed seeking direction to the official respondent(s) to protect the petitioner being harassed by calls being received from international phone numbers and apprehending that there may be some anti-social gang involved, who have also falsely implicated his brother.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed complaints (Annexures P-1 and P-2) dated 01.05.2024 to the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali and to the Incharge Cybercrime, SAS Nagar Mohali raising his grievance as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar Mohali to decide the aforementioned complaint filed by the

petitioner and take necessary action thereon.



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3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. R.S. Thind, DAG Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 2 to decide the aforementioned complaint dated 01.05.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Needless to say, if any threat is found to the petitioner, the official respondents would provide them adequate security in order to protect his life and liberty.
