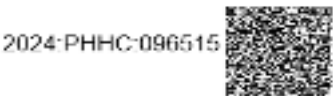
JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 30.05.2013 (Annexure P-3), Award dated 12.05.2014 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 08.09.2014 (Annexure P-7) whereby Tribunal has ordered to reinstate the respondent with continuity of service and back wages.

2. The respondent during the pendency of present petition did not file application under Section 17-B of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 which indicates that respondent is gainfully employed. He is no more interested in reinstatement.

3. Mrs. Abha Rathore, counsel for respondent No.1 submits that respondent should be reasonably compensated for illegal termination.

4. On the asking of Court, Mr. Sharan Sethi, counsel for the



petitioner agrees to pay a sum of ₹2 lakh to respondent within 30 days from today.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to petitioner to pay a sum of ₹2 lakh to respondent within 30 days from the date Mrs. Abha Rathore, supplies address/Bank details of respondent to Mr. Sharan Sethi, counsel for the petitioner.

6. Pending misc. application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
