1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wager service of the petitioner as a qualifying service for the purpose of pensionary benefits for the period from 01.01.1980 to 04.05.1993 alongwith all the consequential benefits as well as interest @ 18 % per annum from the date of its accrual till the date of realization.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner had served a legal notice dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) to respondents No.1 and 3 but the same has not been considered and decided till date. He further submitted that at this stage, he will be satisfied in case the aforesaid legal notice



dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) is considered and decided by respondents No.1 and 3 in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. On the asking of the Court, Ms. Rajni Gupta, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. She submitted that in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, she has no objection in case time bound direction is issued in this regard.
- 5. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without calling for reply from the respondents and without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and decide the legal notice dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure P-4) strictly in accordance with law and within a period of three months from today.
