2. Since the Counsel for the respondent has apprised that the Director, Sports Department, Haryana has already forwarded the case of the petitioners for release of the Cash Awards in terms of the State policy, hence, the factual aspects involved in the present writ petitions are not being gone into.

Mr. Pankaj Mulwani, DAG, Haryana on instructions from Surinder Kumar, Superintendent, Sports Department, Panchkula, Haryana has made a reference to the letter bearing No. Sports Award -2024/22024 dated 01.08.2024 addressed by the Director, Sports Department, that the matter has already been forwarded for approval of the Chief Minister of the State and that the requisite approvals and finances are likely to be released within a period of 08 weeks whereupon the Cash Award as admissible shall be released in favour of the petitioners herein.

In view of the aforesaid statement made on behalf of the State Counsel, the present writ petitions are disposed of with a direction to the respondents to release the admissible Cash Award in favour of the petitioner, in terms of the Policy decision within a period of 08 weeks of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
