The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari for quashing the letter dated 05.07.2022 (Annexure P-9), whereby the posts of ESM-Women (self/dependent) has been given to Male (self), without considering the present petitions which is in violation of the advertisement No.CRA-291/21 vide which 22 posts have been reserved for ex-servicemen (self/dependent) women.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the petitioners have already been offered appointments, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
