As per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and the learned counsel for the Insurance Company, assisted by its authorized representative, a settlement has been arrived at a sum of Rs.12,86,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

The enhanced amount (supra) be paid to the appellant No.1, as per the appended consent statement on record.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.12,86,000/- in the name of the appellant No.1 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent–Insurance Company. The appellant(s) counsel/appellant No.1 may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
