As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representatives of the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹10,00,000/- (₹ Ten Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.1 - Mukesh Rani and appellant No.2 - Laxmi wife of Shri Kanwar Singh, in equal shares.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹10,00,000/- in the names of appellant No.1 - Mukesh Rani and appellant No.2 - Laxmi wife of Shri Kanwar Singh, in equal shares, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.07.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The
