GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. Petitioners-Manish Kumar and Krishan Kumar have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.0025, dated 31.01.2010, Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Sections 379-B, 323, 34 (Sections 379-B deleted and 325 added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 18.07.2023, the parties had been directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statement of

petitioners/accused Manish Kumar and Krishan Kumar and complainants/victims Rakesh Kumar, Ashok Kumar and Parveen Kumar have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. Complainants/victims Rakesh Kumar, Ashok Kumar and Parveen Kumar in their statement had stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bathinda, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion or undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.0025, dated 31.01.2010, Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Sections 379-B, 323, 34 (Sections 379-B deleted and 325 added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
