**Rajbir Sehrawat, J. (Oral)**

1. The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating the contempt proceedings against the respondent for non-complying with order dated 14.12.2023, passed by this Court in CRWP 12001-2023.
2. Notice of motion.
3. On the asking of Court, Mr. Gunjan Menta, Additional Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted; has since been complied and no further action is required to be taken in the matter. Counsel has also placed on record the status report by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh Chahal, IPS. The Registry is directed to tag the aforesaid affidavit on the file after scanning at an appropriate place.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. However, if any of the grievances of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to avail of any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
