1. This is a civil writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no.2 to award suitable marks of NCC certificate dated 23.01.2012 (Annexure P-3) to the petitioner.
