1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3, to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend threat to their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 6, who are averse to their live in relationship.

2. At the outset, learned Standing Counsel for U.T., Chandigarh has placed on record statement of petitioner No.1-Govind Kumar wherein he has categorically deposed that there exists no threat to their life and liberty.

3. In the wake of the statement of petitioner No.1-Govind Kumar, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would not press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. Dismissed as not pressed.
