The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the order dated 03.07.2018 (Annexure P-2), whereby the petitioner, who is working as Clerk at Lohian Khas, has been given the additional charge of the post of Clerk at Nagar Panchayat, Bilga, which is at a distance of 55 kms. away without any extra/additional allowances.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3 submits that the instant petition has been rendered infructuous as the impugned order dated 03.07.2018 has been withdrawn vide order dated 29.04.2024. Copy of order dated 29.04.2024 has been produced by her in the Court which is taken on record.
