In the present petition, the petitioners are claiming that keeping in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court in case titled as “*State of Punjab and others Vs. Jagjit Singh and others*” decided on 26.10.2016, the petitioner is entitled for the grant of minimum of the pay-scale as being granted to the regular employees and further that the petitioner was also entitled for regularisation of his service keeping in view of the Punjab Ad hoc Contractual Daily Wages, Temporary, Work Charges and Outsourced Employees’ Welfare Act, 2016 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised by the petitioner has already been raised through representation dated 09.04.2022, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-8, and the

petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, if the same is decided by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.K. Dogra, Advocate appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in case the representation (Annexure P-8) dated 09.04.2022 has been received in the concerned office, an appropriate order on the same would be passed by respondent No.2 within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondent, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
