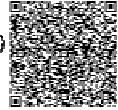

1. Prayer in this petition has been made by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.331 dated 09.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.
2. Vide order dated 13.09. 2024, passed by this Court, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join investigation. Order dated 13.09.2024, passed by this Court, reads as under:

“The present petition has been preferred seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.331 dated 09.11.2023 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 148, 149, 323 and 506 of IPC (Section 325 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station City Ratia, District Fatehabad.

On the basis of statement recorded by the complainant-Deepu on 09.11.2023 alleging therein that on the previous date he was assaulted by the petitioner and the co-



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accused namely Sanjay, Sandeep @ Cobra, Sachin, Vikram @ Majnu and Vikram Gyani and some unknown persons and in that scuffle, he sustained multiple injuries. After registration of the FIR, he apprehending his arrest, the petitioner has moved an application for grant of anticipatory bail, which has been dismissed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fatehabad vide order dated 27.06.2024.

It is argued by the learned counsel for the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in this case. Only simple injuries on the left hand of the complainant-injured has been attributed to the petitioner and he is ready to join the investigation. Custodial interrogation is not required neither any recovery is to be effected from him.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Nidhi Garg, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent(s). She seeks some to file status report.

Adjourned to 08.11.2024.

In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating/Arresting Officer to join investigation within one week or as and when subsequently required thereafter. In the event of his arrest, the Investigating/Arresting Officer shall release the petitioner on interim bail on furnishing personal/surety bonds to his/her satisfaction. The petitioner shall



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*also abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C. ”*

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI-Partap Singh, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 21.09.2024 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 13.09.2024, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to compliance of terms and conditions requisite for grant of anticipatory bail.
