1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/277 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to the respondent to recruit him on the post of Probationary/Management Trainee.

2. Learned counsel for the respondent, at the outset, submits that in view of judgment of Supreme Court in *Rajbir Surajbhan Singh v. Chairman, Institute of Banking Personnel Selection, Mumbai, 2019 (5) JT 35* and Division Bench judgment dated 11.11.2020 of this Court in *Institute of Banking Personnel Selection v. Lakhan Verma and others, LPA No.1597 of 2019*, the writ petition is not maintainable.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner expressed his inability to controvert the applicability of aforesaid judgments to the present case.

4. In view of the aforesaid judgment of Supreme Court and judgment of this Court, the present petition is not maintainable and accordingly dismissed.
5. The petitioner is at liberty to avail remedies as permissible by law.
