RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 12.03.2020 passed in CWP-26598-2015.
2. Short reply dated 22.01.2024 by way of affidavit of Dr. R.S.Dhillon, Director General Elementary Education, Haryana, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 12.03.2020 passed in CWP-26598-2015 has been complied with and necessary payment has been released in favour of the petitioners.
4. Counsel for the petitioners has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left un-addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
