Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that prayer in the present petition is for amending the application filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. as the petitioner, after filing the aforementioned application, has come in possession of certain evidence with regard to ownership of respondent of some immovable property as well as his bank accounts and PPF account. The respondent is concealing his actual income to avoid his liability.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file an appropriate application before the learned Family Court seeking production of these documents to prove the actual income of respondent.

Learned counsel for respondent submits that in view of the provisions contained in Section 14 of the Family Courts Act, the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. are summary in nature and the rigors of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 would not apply.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
