Present appeal has been filed under Section 14-A(2) of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities), Act, 1989 (*for short, 'the SC&ST Act'*) against order dated 11.06.2024 passed by learned Special Court, Faridabad, for grant of bail pending trial to the appellant in FIR No. 252 dated 01.10.2023 under Sections 120B,323,324,307,302,506 read with Section 34 & Section 148 read with Section 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short 'IPC') and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 and Sections 3(2)(v) of the SC&ST Act, registered at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad.
