By way of filing the instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner has approached this Court for issuance of writ in the nature of *certiorari* or any other suitable writ or directions to the respondent/corporation to pass a order for treating the period spent by the petitioner under suspension as well as dismissal as a period spent on duty for all intents and purposes and consequential release of full pay and allowances to the petitioner with interest @ 21 % as per the provisions of Rule 7.3 (2) (3) of Punjab Civil Services Rules, Volume – I, Part-I and writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondent/corporation to complete service book of the petitioner and and send his pension papers to the Employees Provident Fund Organisation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he has already filed a representation dated 05.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) claiming the above said relief and he would be satisfied, if time bound directions are issued to the respondents to consider and decide the said representation.

On reversal to the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, learned counsel for the respondent submis that the said representation dated 05.06.2018 (Annexure P-6) shall be disposed of within a period of three months from today by passing a detailed and well reasoned speaking order.

Disposed of with the aforesaid terms.
