This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 25.09.2019 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.2 vide which the petitioner has been directed to vacate the dwelling house within two months.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he is not in touch with his client and thus, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous but liberty be granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present case or to file a fresh petition, in case, any cause survives to her.
