PARAMJEET SINGH, J.

Instant writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* to quash the award dated 26.08.2015 (Annexure P-10) and order dated 09.09.2015 (Annexure P-12) passed by respondent No.1 – Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Narnaul (hereinafter referred to as 'PLAPUS'), whereby petitioner has been directed to reimburse amount to respondents No.2 to 4 to the extent of ₹ 10.00 lacs plus interest which has accrued on that amount.

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I need not reproduce the facts of the case as the issue involved in this case has been dealt with by this Court in CWP No.7031 of 2014 titled '***The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd. and another v. Gurdarshan Singh and another***' decided on 19.09.2015.

The decision rendered in the case of ***The Branch Manager, Bajaj Allianz Life Insurance Co. Ltd.*** (supra) is fully applicable to the present writ petition and as such liable to be dismissed.

Resultantly, this writ petition is dismissed.
