1. Petitioner has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for directions to the respondent No.2 to protect life and liberty of petitioner at the hands of unknown persons/unknown callers who are giving threat calls to petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On asking of this Court, Mr. Kewal Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab accepts notice on behalf of State. He confirmed that police has already received representations (Annexure P-1 and P-2) and matter is under investigation. It is further stated that these representations will be decided within a period of 10 days.

4. Considering aforesaid factual position respondent Nos.2 and 3 are directed to dispose of the aforesaid representations by taking concrete



steps and further life and liberty of the petitioner and his family be protected as and when required considering threat perception.

5. With aforesaid directions, present petition is, accordingly, disposed of.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
