1. In the present writ petition, the challenge is to the charg-sheet dated 17.04.2018 (Annexure P-33), which has been issued to the petitioner.

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2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the interim order passed in CWP No. 9008 of 2018, no action on the charge-sheet has been taken so far.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has done no wrong and he intends to prove that the allegations alleged in the charge-sheet are false and frivolous hence, directions be issued to the respondents to conclude the departmental proceedings in a time bound manner as the petitioner has already retired from service.

4. Learned State counsel submits that in case the petitioner cooperate, the enquiry proceedings will be concluded within a period of four months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further but liberty be given to the petitioner that in case any order causing prejudice to the petitioner is passed, the petitioner can avail appropriate remedy of all the available grounds.

6. Ordered accordingly.
