1. In the present writ petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that his juniors have been promoted to the post of Statistical Assistant whereas, the claim of the petitioner has been declined on the ground that the petitioner is facing criminal proceedings (in FIR No.348 dated 03.12.2015).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already retired from service though the criminal proceedings are still pending hence, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner that in case the petitioner is acquitted in the criminal proceedings, he can raise appropriate claim before the authorities concerned for consideration of his claim for promotion to the post of Statistical Assistant w.e.f. the date persons junior to him were promoted with all consequential benefits.
