This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for disobeying the order dated 02.05.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-9153-2022.

Compliance report by way of affidavit of respondent filed in the Registry is taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the order dated 02.05.2022 passed by this Court has been complied with and speaking order dated 11.10.2023 has been passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
