JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to release disability pension in terms of Central Civil Services (Extraordinary Pension) Rules, 1939.
2. The petitioner is a retired Naik. He on 02.07.1966 joined respondent-Border Security Force as Constable. In 1970, during the course of employment, he sustained injury and was hospitalized. He, in view of report of the Medical Board, was declared permanently disabled with 30% disability. The petitioner on 03.06.1980 was declared invalid and discharged from service.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per order dated 20.07.2012 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner was extended benefit of disability pension whereas till date he has not actually received disability

pension. By communication dated February’ 2013 (Annexure P-5) and 12.03.2013 (Annexure P-6), the respondents have converted invalid pension into disability pension, however, he has not received benefit of disability pension.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents-UOI does not dispute the authenticity of Annexures P-4, P-5 and P-6 and submits that Competent Authority would look into the matter and find out reason of non-release of disability pension in terms of aforesaid orders.

5. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the respondents-UOI, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to look into the matter and redress grievance of the petitioner within 3 months from today.
