1. Present writ petition has been filed by the petitioner-Bhag Singh, aged 71 years, seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to release all the retiral/pensionary benefits of the petitioner i.e. Arrears of Pension, difference of leave encashment, revision of Pension, DCRG (Retirement Gratuity) etc, for which the petitioner is otherwise legally entitled as is clear from the communications dated 10.05.2023 (Annexure P-6) and 11.05.2023 (Annexure P-7) and 01.08.2023 (Annexure P-10) of the respondents-Authorities.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner pointed out that for the similar relief, the petitioner had earlier approached this Court (Punjab and

Haryana High Court) and filed a CWP-9338-2011, decided on 04.08.2022, which was disposed of as not being pressed, expecting that the consequential benefits for which the petitioner is otherwise entitled would be released in due course of time to the petitioner.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab, appearing on receipt of advance copy of petition, submits that the claim of the petitioner would be finalized within three months from today and the present writ petition can be disposed of by issuing the necessary directions to the respondents.

4. After going through the pleadings raised through the present writ petition and the documents appended thereto as well as noticing the fact the petitioner had earlier approached this Court for claiming the similar relief, present writ petition is disposed of by issuing directions to the respondents to consider and decide the request of the petitioner as noticed hereabove and in case, petitioner is found to be entitled for the relief claimed, then same be released to him with all the consequential pensionary benefits etc. within a period of three months from today i.e. 16.10.2024.

5. With the aforementioned terms, the present writ petitioner is disposed of.
