1. The petitioner – Sat Narain has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 193 dated 04.05.2024 under Section 379 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, District Ambala.

2. As per the facts of case, FIR has been registered on the statement of Vijay Kumar complainant who stated that on 04.03.2024 at about 11:30 AM, he went to State Bank of India, Bhrankumari Chowk on Activa bearing No.HR-01-R-4220 and withdrew Rs.4 lakhs from the bank and kept the same in the trunk of his activa. He again went inside the bank to make entry in the pass-book and when he returned back, he noticed that some unknown person had stolen Rs.4 lakhs from the trunk of his Activa. Investigation was carried



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out and the accused was nominated on the basis of CCTV footage. Accused was arrested on 04.05.2024.

3. Learned counsel for petitioner argued that matter has been compromised with complainant. Photocopy of compromise is also placed on record which is signed by complainant-Vijay Kumar and Anju Bala wife of Sat Narain. It is pointed out that cash amount was also recovered. Petitioner is behind the bars. He is ready to abide by the terms of bail order. It is prayed that his regular bail application may kindly be allowed.

4. Status report was filed through Registry, which is taken on record. It is confirmed that petitioner is arrested on 04.05.2024. His disclosure statement is Annexure R-2. Stolen currency notes and Activa bearing No. HR-01-R-4220 were taken into police possession. After completion of investigation, challan has been prepared on 04.06.2024 and it is presented in the Court on 11.06.2024. Now it is fixed for consideration on charge.

5. Ms. Sanchita Jindal, Advocate appeared on behalf of complainant and filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. However, she confirmed the compromise with petitioner and did not oppose the bail application.

6. I have considered the arguments and have gone through the record. Aforesaid facts indicate that matter has been compromised with the complainant. Even otherwise, petitioner was arrested and joined in the investigation. Currency notes were recovered. After completion of investigation, challan is also presented in the Court. In view of the aforesaid factual position, without going on the merits of the case, regular bail application filed by the petitioner – Sat Narain is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the



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satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Judge concerned.

7. Petition is accordingly, allowed.

8. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stand disposed of accordingly as well.
