Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the petitioners are entitled for the grant of benefit under the Old Pension Scheme, keeping in view the judgment of this Court in ***“Jeewan Lata Vs. State of Punjab and others”*** passed in CWP No.10238 of 2017 decided on 10.05.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised in the representation dated 18.03.2024, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-8, and the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage, if the same is decided by passing appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG Punjab appears and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that in case the representation (Annexure P-8) dated 18.03.2024 has been received in the office, an appropriate order on the same would be passed by respondent No.2 within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of copy of this order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioners, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed, which will be conveyed to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that keeping in view the statement of the learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.
