1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of interim bail for a period of 4 days to the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. in FIR No. 108 dated 15.04.2022 under Section 346 IPC (Section 302, 120-B, 201, 328, 376D IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kalayat, District Kaithal on the ground that marriage of the real brother of the petitioner is scheduled for 15.07.2024 whereas the other functions and ceremonies are going to be held on 13.07.2024.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the application moved by the petitioner for grant of interim bail has been dismissed by the learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Special Court, Kaithal vide order dated 09.07.2024 on the ground of seriousness of alleged offence. However, the petitioner has been permitted to attend the ceremonies pertaining to marriage

in Police custody on 15.07.2024 from 10 A.M. to 5 P.M. subject to deposit of transportation charges.

3. Notice of the said application to the State.
4. Mr. Pawan Kumar Jhanda, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and has filed short reply by way of affidavit of Lalit Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kalayat, District Kaithal and verified the factum of marriage of brother of the petitioner, as per the verification report (Annexure R1/T to R3/T)
5. Learned State counsel has opposed the bail application on the ground of seriousness of allegations against the petitioner.
6. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail till 16.07.2024, subject to furnishing personal bonds in the amount of Rs. 5 Lakhs with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned and shall surrender back before the trial Court on 17.07.2024.
7. Disposed of.
