This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.10.2023 passed in CWP-22943-2023.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gunjan Mehta, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 4 and has submitted that neither these respondents have stopped the petitioner from performing the duties in OAT Centre, Jand Sahib nor have they passed any further order adverse to the petitioner. So far as respondent Nos.2 and 3 are concerned, though they have passed the transfer order but there is no order restraining them; because they were not even impleaded as party to the writ petition.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to proceed further in the present petition.

Dismissed.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
