Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.45 dated 27.06.2024, under Sections 452, 323, 148 & 149 IPC Act, registered at Police Station Raman, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 15.07.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners has submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.07.2024, petitioners have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh, affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.07.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
